Report of the Science Academies Lecture-Workshop on

"Biodiversity of Human Welfare"

A two day Science Academies Lecture Workshop on "Biodiversity of Human Welfare" was held in Alva's College, Moodubidire on 19th & 20th September 2018. The Lecture workshop was sponsored by the Science Academies, Indian Academy of Science (IASc) Bengaluru, Indian National Science Academy (INSA), and National Academy of Science (NASI) New Delhi. The Lecture workshop was organized by the Department of Research and Development Alva's College, Moodubidire.Dr. R. R.Rao, INSA Honorary Scientist, Bengaluru was the convenor Dr Raghavendra Rao, Associate Professor& Coordinator Department of Research and Development, Alva's College, Moodubidire was coordinator of this programme.
