
REPORT OF THE DRAWING WORKSHOP

Objective: To convey the importance of daily sketches and drawing.

He has received 13 awards from different institutions which include, the Kerala Lalitha Kala Academy Award in 1992, the Award for the most original work from India International arts centre, Kolkata in 1993, the Working artists association award Orissa in 1993, the Bombay Arts society in 1994, the Bendre Husain Fellowship in 1994, the Junior fellowship from ministry of cultural affairs of India in 1994 and the Kejriwal Award for young Artists Bangalore in 1999.

Event details: The workshop was conducted from 1st, 3rd to 5th of October, 2018. The event began with a formal inaugural function at 10:00 am, with the welcome speech, followed by florally welcoming the guest.

The workshop included 5 sessions, viz., meaning of art, study of complex minute objects around us, outdoor nature study, outdoor architecture study, and outdoor market and life study respectively. The students were given guidance about the various methods that make- up easy sketches by consuming less time.


