1. DOOR TO DOOR CLEANLINESS CAMPAIGN ON 26TH MAY 2018



Alva's Air Wing NCC (Flight – B) had conducted campaign visiting every house in the Ulaydangadi, Mijar at Moodbidri on 26th May 2018. Total of 16 cadets and one ANO had taken part in this campaign. The motto of campaign is to collect the data from the local residents, as to how they are disposing dry & wet waste at their houses. Campaign was also to create the awareness among local residents about advantages of segregating dry waste & wet waste (waste management).

Cadets had visited to approximately 23+ houses and collected the data. It had been noted that, some residential house are not using municipal vehicle to dispose their waste, instead they are burning dry

waste including plastic & wet waste they through at plants at their houses. Some residents have complained that, the municipal vehicle comes only 2 days in a week, and it is difficult for resident to hold the waste till then. It also been noted that, vehicles cannot reach the interior houses. So some method should be implemented to reach out to the interior houses. After survey, we conclude with a statement that, "People need to be more educated, as they don't give much importance to the segregation of wastes; Changing People mind set is the biggest challenge ahead of everyone. And it is the responsibility of all the citizens to collectively work towards the development in one direction."



3. SWCHATHA – HI – SEVA CAMPAIGN ORGANISED BY THE EX-SERVICE MEN'S ASSOCIATION OF DAKSHINA KANNADA DISTRICT 28TH SEP 2018







SWCHATHA HI SEVA- Campaign was organised at Yedapadav village, Moodbidri on 28th Sept. 2018 in accordance with nationwide Swacha Bharat cleanliness camp Organized with Ex-Service Men's Organisation, Mangalore.
